



## Home Learning at Bellfield

All classes are now setting work through the timetable system on the school website. Teachers are sending support and additional resources via SeeSaw to accompany the timetabled activities.

We appreciate that this mean there isn't a physical, printed pack for children to work from and they will need some access to an electronic device that is connected to the internet.



Although this means some families, with multiple children, will have to share a device, children will only need to use the device for a short time to access the links provided. Once the activity has been seen and understood by the child, they should be able to complete the activity on paper.

Some tips on how to manage distance learning:

- Look at the timetable in advance and work out what resources are needed.
- Create your own timetable of sessions when devices are available and do those activities in a block if needed.
- With multiple children, split the day into half (morning/afternoon) when each can use the device for their learning. In the alternate session, the other child will need to complete offline activities.
- If you cannot access the links provided for any reason, follow the same area/aspect of learning to do some activities on paper (e.g. finding half, writing a diary etc.)
- Mix the order of the lessons to work for your family.

We appreciate that it is a very difficult time for everyone. Do whatever you can, when you can, for it to work for your family and circumstances.
