Opening school for more children – Monday 1st June 2020

We are running several “bubble groups” with children of Key Workers or pupils who are in a more vulnerable position at this present time. We are a small school and therefore all groups are now **full** with places that have been offered to those who are in need due to returning to key working jobs.

As a small school, we have to be very careful with ensuring social distancing can be adhered to, therefore we are trying to have minimal staffing in the school building at any one point, this is another reason for us being full at this time.

What will happen moving forward?

We will be continuously reviewing our practices as we go through June. At the end of June we will review all groups and **if** it is safe to offer more places to pupils then we will look to do so. Again, **priority** will be given to children of **key workers, vulnerable** and then children from the **Reception class**.

Once again, thank you for your support and the **AMAZING** home learning that is taking place. You really are doing a fantastic job. We will continue to provide work for at home and hope that you will continue to use our Seesaw Activities as a way of sharing with your child’s teacher the brilliant work.
