Phonics:

This week in phonics we are focusing on the sounds we can hear in the environment around us. Can you go on a walk and listen to the sounds around you? What can you hear? **Challenge:** Can you remember what you heard when you go back inside?

Talk 4 Writing:

This week in Talk 4 Writing we are re-reading our term story "We're going on a bear hunt" We will then, as the week progresses, look at all of the characters "Who" are in the story. Maths:

Once we are able to recognise how many objects are in a pile just from looking. Science:

This week in science we are looking at pumpkins and over the week we will be cutting the pumpkin open and observing the changes and discussing what the texture feels like and how it smells.

Creative:

This week to be creative we are drawing pictures of the wellies we would wear if we were to go on a bear hunt. **Challenge:** Can you use the muscles in your hands to scrunch and tear some paper to stick onto your picture?

Other activities:

This week we are focusing on sharing and taking turns. We plan to pass an object around our circle and state what we like about the weather outside and how it has changed from the summer term. Can you take turns to speak and show "good listening" when someone else is talking?
