



# Bellfield Remote Learning



Whilst we are faced with many children accessing our curriculum remotely, we will strive to provide a *consistent* approach which provides access to the lessons which children would have taken part in, if they were in school.

## How is this provided?

- Teachers will upload work daily onto the child's SeeSaw account.
- Where necessary, this will be differentiated to the child's needs.
- Lessons will meet the 3 hours for KS1 and 4 hours for KS2.
- They will receive phonics (EYFS/KS1), spelling, reading, basic skills, literacy, maths, topic, PE and science, music and RE.
- There will be access to PowerPoints, models, steps to success, examples, videos, voice recordings and teacher explanations which will support the children in their learning.
- The work can be completed in the way that suits the child and family best (paper, on screen, typed etc.). However, we are unable to provide printed work packs.

## What else do we offer?

- Live weekly Zoom calls with teachers to focus on PSHE and well-being.
- Targeted Zoom sessions with teaching assistants in different curriculum areas (reading, phonics and maths)
- The work is responded to by the adult, feedback provided and further support given, if needed.
- We showcase the work produced by the children working remotely on the Remote Learning displays in each phase in school
- Each class chooses one child for a 'Good Work' certificate each week which is celebrated on our Twitter page.
