

Year 2 - Home Reading Support Questions

Here are some questions that will help support children during home reading sessions. If you have any questions regarding home reading please see your child's class teacher.

How do you know someone is talking in a story?

How does punctuation (e.g. full stop) help us to read for sense?

Who is the main character in the story? How do you know this?

What happened in the story?

Find some words or phrases which tell you about the setting.

What made you choose this book?

What would you like the story/text to be about?

Which character from the story interests you?

Based on the cover, what do you think the story will be about?

What is the main event in this story?

Were you surprised by the ending? Is it what you expected?

Has the author put certain words in bold or italics? Why?

Can you find any amazing adjectives?

Can you think of another way to begin this story?

What was the most exciting part of the story? What made it success?

What is the author's view of events in the story? How can you tell?

Did you enjoy the book? Why?

Was there any part of the story or text that you didn't like? Why?

Where and when do you think the story is set?

What sort of book is it? How can you tell?

What features of the text tell you that it is a story?
